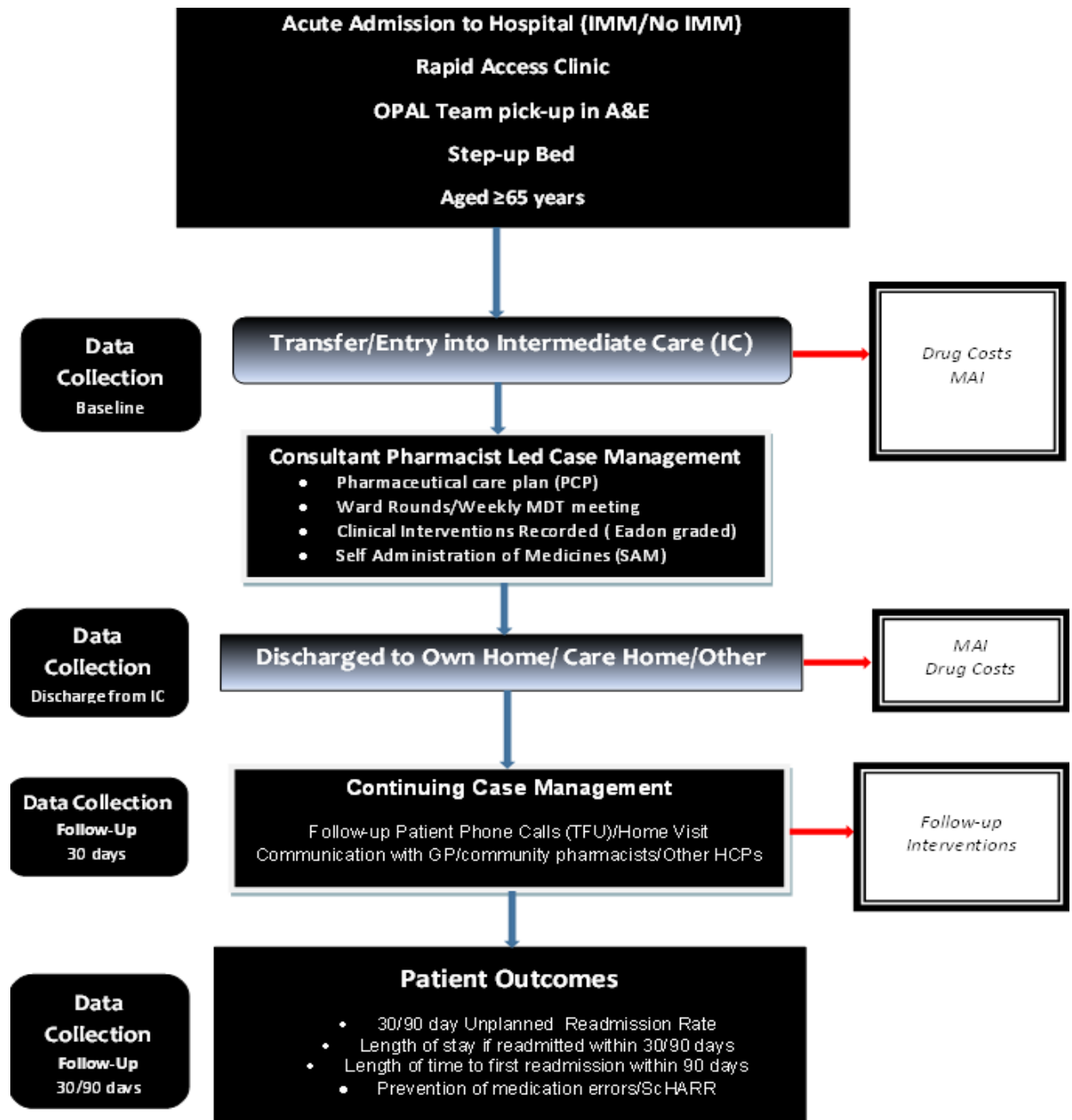

# Outcomes

|  | WHST RESULTS | NHSCT RESULTS |
|--|--------------|---------------|
| Average number of medicines on admission         | 10.9 ± 4.1   | 10.4 ± 4.3    |
| Average number of medicines on discharge         | 9.9 ± 4.2    | 9.4 ± 4.0     |
| Average MAI on admission                         | 13.0 ± 10.5  | 16.1 ± 12.4   |
| Average MAI on discharge                         | 0.1 ± 0.6    | 1.5 ± 3.4     |
| Average Clinical Interventions per patient       | 5.2 ± 2.7    | 4.0 ± 2.3     |
| Average amount saved per patient                 | £211.88      | £214.68       |
| Projected annual primary care drug budget saving | £105k        | £107k         |
